Deanna Tsang

Good Morning everybody, my name is Deanna. I grew up in Christian home, I remember I have been going to church for as long as I remember. I moved to Beijing, China for grades 1-8, where freedom of religion was very restricted China and my family went to a church where only foreigners were allowed. This church was so large that each service had thousands in



attendance every Sunday. With Cantonese, Mandarin, and English congregations. Because it was so big I never had a chance to get to know the Lord on a personal level; I was just going to church because my family did. As far as I was concerned Beijing was my home, I had no Christian friends, I had no Christian community and it didn't bother me at all, that life was all I knew. In grade 8 there was a series of events that happened in my life I could never have imagined. I had was hospitalized for having trouble breathing, both a very good friend of mine and my best friend's mother passed away, and my parents decided move across the world to Toronto away from everyone and everything I knew. At this time I had hit a low. I was lost, angry and very frustrated. I was mad at God. All my life I had been told God is a merciful Lord, he loves every last person, and he's always there for you. So I kept asking him why. I kept asking myself, if there really was a God how could he let things like this happen? How could he allow this? With this this toxic attitude, I moved to Canada and began high school in an alien country as far away from God as I ever was.

It was purely by God's grace that one day in grade 10 I decided to check out my sisters Tumblr website, (an online blogging platform) and saw her posting bible versus and about how god had been working in her life. It resonated with me because I had never witnessed someone 'from my generation' walking with Christ, as I never had a chance to have a Christian community or see people who lived with God in their lives. From that time I felt a pull to Christ. I thought, maybe it's possible to know my sisters God, maybe there's more to Christ than I know. So I tried to listen to his word in Sunday school, during sermons, and I tried to find my way through him. But I wasn't fully walking in his path. Stumbling between wanting a relationship with God and wanting to live life on my own terms. Last year, STM came around and God placed a heavy burden in my heart to go. I was hesitant because I didn't think I was 'Christian enough' or good enough in any sense, but God spoke to me and said: "I gave you life, so it's your turn to give your life to me." In hearing that, I decided to follow Christ not just as a Sunday routine but as a new life in him. I accepted that I'm imperfect. He died for all of us out of love, and saved us all. Looking back now I truly am blessed with God's plans. I saw everything he had planned in my life was to bring me to him and the way he has worked in my life that's given me a new understanding, patience, and peace that I find in the Lord knowing he is the one above everything.

Shernei Wang

Good Morning everybody, my name is Shernei Wang. After I was born, my mother brought my sister and I to church in Canada, but around a year later, we had to move to Malaysia. Since my mother was foreign to the country and had no friends at the time, we stopped going to church. My father's family worshiped Buddhism and that was what I grew up worshiping as well. It wasn't until



2005 when my father was diagnosed with stroke, and a Christian couple had visited my family. They shared their testimonies with us and invited us to church that Saturday, and since then, we continued attending church. During that time, my father's situation was becoming worse. He was a stubborn man, and for a while, he didn't want to open up his heart to accepting Christ as his Lord and savior. Everyone at church prayed for him, and slowly, his illness started to fade. Eventually, he accepted Jesus and was baptized with my mother. Through many years of prayers, I was able to witness God's healing through my father, and because of this miracle, I was able to see that God is real. Not so long after moving back to Canada in 2007, a friend from school invited my family and I to NCAC where I met a lot of amazing people that experienced through the tough and happy moments in my life.

Throughout my walk with God, I have stumbled many times and doubted His work. Many unfortunate events has happened in my life, which led me to question God many times. I have fell away from God previously and had based my achievements in life solely upon my own hard work. However, every time I distanced myself with God, He always pulled me back. Whenever I became

depressed, I noticed that I never felt completely alone. There was always a constant reminder in my head telling me to trust God and to place my burdens in His hands, and He will do the rest.

God has placed many influential people in my life so that He can perform His work through them, in order to shape me into the person He wants me to be. I believe everything that has happened in my life so far is all planned out by God and that nothing was coincidental. God sent me to earth to witness the miracles that he has performed in my life so that I can share his doings in my testimony today. There is a scripture in the bible that helped me make this important step in my walk with God. It's about John the Baptist who preached about the Gospel to people of Judea and asked them to repent and whoever believes in the Gospel can be baptized. It says, "People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River." (Matthew 3:4-6). Just like that, people who believed in Jesus were baptized. I remember my Sunday school teacher, Sam Yeung, asking us thought provoking questions about baptism one day. He taught us that it is actually not our personal readiness that decides whether we are ready to get baptized, but it is God's decisions. I realize that God has planned out my entire life on earth, and one of them includes getting baptized. Looking back, I remember the comfort that God has given to me during my lowest and joy at my highest, and has blessed me with everything I need in my life. Without Him, I will never be satisfied, as my life will never be complete. Thank you, and God bless.

William Qiu

I was not born into a Christian family but I remember times when I was young that I would attend my neighborhood church. I was too young at that time to know who Jesus Christ was and what it meant to be a Christian. I didn't have much say on what I wanted to do but I remember that my brother stopped going because his friends stopped going, which in turn made me stop going too. Up until the summer of grade 6, Raymond Kwong, who I met at Kumon, told me to



come to his church which was New Covenant Alliance Church. I wanted to be nice and didn't want to turn the offer down, so I decided to go. I remember meeting my first few friends that day. I don't remember if I got along with them, but I must have because I came back the following weeks. But one thing still remained the same, I didn't understand who Jesus Christ was and what Christianity was all about. I was always shy when it came to bible studies and story time. I never had interest to listen nor participate. It all seemed like fun and games to me. Recently in the summer during our softball season, I really started to think about my walk with God after hearing the many stories and testimonies of other players and how they accepted Jesus as their Savior who died on the cross for their sins. I remembered that I would have had some problems during some of the weeks of summer and I would pray for guidance and help. I would go to service the following week, and the message perfectly addresses to my problem and I was just astonished. At first I thought it was just a coincidence that I was able to relate to it so well. I would continually pray for myself and I would come back the next week hearing a message that felt like God was speaking to me. There were recurring moments where I noticed God was present in my life which really stuck out and caught my attention. After spending more time with God and learning what it means to be a Christian, I am now able to say that I accept Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior who died on the cross for me to save me from sin. Knowing how I am saved by the love of God is truly a blessing that will definitely influence my actions for the rest of my life.
