Through that experience, I submitted my life back into His hands – surrendering my all, and leaving my future up to wherever he wanted to take me.

Looking back, it wasn't on my own merit that I accomplished all things, but it was purely God's grace that I am where I am today. I'm able to see how he was there with me every step of the way all these years—despite how much I may have neglected and ignored Him. There was nothing more profound than meeting Jesus at the most desperate point of my life.

It hasn't been easy surrendering everything to God, handing the steering wheel of my life over to him— and I admit I still struggle with relying on Him 100%. But, I believe getting baptised is most definitely a very important step to take in this life-long journey of following Christ—and I know that there will continue to be challenges along the way—if anything, the challenges will only prove to be tougher, but I believe that God will be by my side throughout this uphill battle.

Then I met Vincent Yeung, a former elder of the church who originally was only supposed to upgrade my computer but then eventually we got to talking, became close friends and as we got to know each other. While bed ridden and partially recovering I wasn't sure what to think of that suggestion but he assured me with confidence as a true friend that I had nothing to lose. Isabella Huang (黃繹真姊妹)

I had a really happy childhood, despite having grown up in a non Christian family. However, I did know that people went to church by hearing about it from neighbours and classmates. Although I didn't have a personal relationship with Jesus, I was aware of the fact that there may be a god out there. My parents were extremely hard working and did



their best to provide for my sister and me. It was always their goal to send me to a private school for better academics, and by the time I was 10, they could finally afford it. They enrolled me in a Christian private school, because my neighbour had gone to that one several years ago, and because my mom probably liked the idea of them serving us hot lunches every day. I vividly remember my first day of school there, because I had absolutely no idea what was going on. Our first activity in class was to draw a picture of our favourite Bible verse. I was sitting in the back row, watching my classmates excitedly start drawing pictures, without any idea what to do. I ended up having to ask the girl beside me what a Bible and what a verse was.

Of course, my confusion was short-lived because I soon caught up to all the Bible stories and learned that Jesus was my saviour. I remember feeling so joyful knowing that I was saved and knowing that I have a heavenly Father who loves me. Life suddenly had a different meaning for me, even at such a young age. After a few years, my mother and grand-mother also became Christians due to our new influences. It was amazing to see the changes in my family throughout those years.

After leaving my Christian elementary school, I realized that my faith only seemed strong because I was living in a Christian bubble every day. In high school, it was no longer "easy" to be a Christian, and I found myself in a phase when I basically pushed God out of my life and tried to live independently from Him. Fortunately, by His grace I realized in the end how empty life is without Him. By the end of high school, I desired to make my faith my own and to journey with God in more than just a superficial way.

Throughout university, I really grew a lot closer to the Lord. He has repeatedly shown me how faithful He is and that His will is always better than mine. He provided me brothers and sisters who fellowship with me and keep me accountable, wherever I go. I also actively sought out answers to questions I struggled with and learned how to defend my faith and discuss with others. I pray that God will continue teaching me how to love Him and how to find my identity in Him. It is still an ongoing journey of course, but I am baptized today to declare that it's one I will continue on for the rest of my life.

Kealy Huynh

I was raised in a Buddhist family, and I came to know Christ 4 years ago during high school in grade 12.

When I first heard of the Gospel it was from a friend, he explained how Jesus died on the cross for all sinners, the only thing I could think of was how much pain Jesus had to endure, but I didn't understand that He died for me nor did I accept Christ the first time I heard of the good news. However, I found myself talking and praying to God more over the next year.



My friend shared the gospel with for the second time. And this time, I was able to realize, see the love that Christ has for me. That through the cross, He delivered me from my sins, that I deserve death but because of Him, I am counted righteous in God's eyes and no longer have to face condemnation. Though, I wouldn't say I really understood the gospel this time, but I understood that I owe my life to Christ. That being said, I finally prayed to God and asked for His forgiveness for all of my sins, I became His follower by accepting what Christ did on the cross for me.

My parents eventually learned about this and we got into a big fight. I was forced to choose between God and them, and the consequence of choosing God was getting kicked out of the house. I chose God and left the house that night. Wow, how faithful I was to be willing to leave my parents for the Lord though not really. Looking back, I was just a spoiled and prideful immature teenager that thought, "God will definitely take care of me so I don't need my parents". I stayed at my friend's house that night and I was told by his mother to

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"honour your parents". So I went back to my parents, and made a deal with them. They said that I could believe in God but I could not go to church.

To be honest, I wouldn't call myself a Christian after that. Through the ways I lived, the way I behaved, I still loved this world. Instead of doing the things that pleases God, I was still holding on to my life, clinging to it, and following what this world does. I struggled constantly through my walk with God because of my sins. My faith fluctuated a lot, sometimes it's really low and sometimes it's high. I found myself longing for stableness and constant growth in the Lord instead of falling back and forth. Eventually it got to a point where I didn't know what to do, I felt stranded.

September 2015, I started to attend a fellowship at school. I was able to meet a lot of Christians who devoted themselves to the Lord. God used them and directed me to Him. God truly showed me how powerful He is through that. He allowed me to experience a life with Christ in a deeper way. I started to read the Bible and do devotions more regularly; seeking different resources that would help my faith grow. I was able to see God's plans for me as His followers, and through Him, I seek to glorify Him in everything I do.

God has shown me grace and love everyday; He gave me the desires to live for Him and to suffer for Christ's sakes. And only lately my parents finally gave me permission to go to church! Which is why I've been attending NCAC, and would love to be part of the church community.
