- 1. Logon to your online banking
- 2. Navigate to the Interac e-Transfer section.
- 3. Create/add a new contact/recipient name.
- 4. Then enter our church offering email address: donate@ncac.ca
- 5. Enter the following Information in the "Message" section:
- a. Name of donor and/or offering number of donor
- b. Address of donor (necessary for a new donor)

c. Allocation of the offering amount (if not specify, the total amount will go to General Fund). Example: General - \$ 200, Building Repair - \$100; Mission - \$100, Love Fund – 100, others (please specify)

6. Enter the Security Question and answer: Please use "ncacoffering" for answer. If use different answer please communicate the answer to the Elder Francis Lee (1-647-278-3702).

You can also send your offerings by mail to church address 1490 Birchmount Rd. Scarborough, ON M1P 2E3, to the attention of Finance department. If by mail, please send only cheque but not cash.
