(Different banks may have different ways or settings for e-transfer. The following gives you a general idea.)

- 1. Logon to the online banking of your bank
- 2. Navigate to the Interac e-Transfer section.
- 3. Create or add a new contact or recipient name (e.g. NCAC)
- 4. Then enter our church e-offering email address: donate@ncac.ca
- 5. Enter the following information in the "Message" section:
- a. Name of donor and/or offering number of donor
- b. Address of donor (necessary for a new donor)

c. Allocation of the offering amount (if not specified, the total amount will go to the General Fund). Example: General - \$ 200, Building Repair - \$100; Mission - \$100, Love Fund – 100, others (please specify) 6. Enter the Security Question and answer: Please use "offering" for the security question and "ncacoffering" for the security answer. If you use different answer please communicate the answer to the Elder Francis Lee (1-647-278-3702).
