The Finance department has attained an automatic deposit e-transfer service with the bank and it has been operating smoothly in the last two weeks. Starting this week, the Finance department will only send emails to brothers and sisters who make their first e-transfer to confirm their donation amount.. If you have not receive email confirmation from our church finance please contact Ricky Leung as soon as possible.

Our new electronic transfer of offering is now on Auto deposit.

There is no need for security question and answer. Please see instruction below (Different banks may have different ways or settings for e-transfer. The following gives you a general idea.):

- 1. Logon to the online banking of your bank
- 2. Navigate to the Interac e-Transfer section.
- 3. Create or add a new contact or recipient name (e.g. NCAC)
- 4. Then enter our church e-offering email address: donate@ncac.ca
- 5. Security question is not required as auto-deposit is now enabled.
- 6. Enter the following information in the "Message" section:
 - a. Name of donor and/or offering number of donor
 - b. Address of donor (necessary for a new donor)
- c. Allocation of the offering amount (if not specified, the total amount will go to the General Fund). Example: General - \$ 200, Building Repair - \$100; Mission - \$100, Love Fund – 100, others (please specify)

You can also send your offerings in cheque by mail to church address 1490 Birchmount Rd. Scarborough, ON M1P 2E3, to the attention of the Finance department. If by mail, please send a cheque and not cash.
