REFLECTION FOR THE WEEK

Read: Matthew 11: 1-6

After Jesus had finished instructing his twelve disciples, he went on from there to teach and preach in the towns of Galilee.² When John, who was in prison, heard about the deeds of the Messiah, he sent his disciples³ to ask him, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?"

⁴ Jesus replied, "Go back and report to John what you hear and see: ⁵ The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor. ⁶ Blessed is anyone who does not stumble on account of me."

- *Why do you think John was questioning if Jesus was "The One" even though he already knew who Jesus was in John 1: 29?*

- *What can we learn from the answer of Jesus?*

5. Security question is not required as auto-deposit is now enabled.
6. Enter the following information in the “Message” section:

- a. Name of donor and/or offering number of donor
- b. Address of donor (necessary for a new donor)
- c. Allocation of the offering amount (if not specified, the total amount will go to the General Fund). Example: General - \$ 200, Building Repair - \$100; Mission - \$100, Love Fund – 100, others (please specify)

NCAC COVID19 Community Support team: As you know, brothers and sisters at NCAC have supported the community through this pandemic through monetary donations, disposable and homemade mask donations, non-perishable food donations, and volunteering to deliver hot meals to seniors. Homemade masks have been requested by Saint Elizabeth Health Care and Carefirst Seniors and Community Services to support the health and community services they provide. In total, they provide services to about 17,000 clients and have asked the community to donate homemade masks to help with their work.

COVID-19 is still not over: As some of you may have already noticed, further government guidelines for re-opening places of worship in Ontario have been released and are more restrictive than expected. While this is challenging and disappointing, our C&MA District urges local churches to be patient and to trust God's timing in all of this and to honour our government and health officials for their hard work. NCAC is preparing church facility and work on renovation to ensure health safety. Board and ministry leaders have started discussion to draft a workable plan. All the ministries will continue to be online. Thank you for your prayers and support.
