Criteria of the items:

1. Toys and clothing must be new or in good condition.
2. These are the preferred non-perishable food items: Tuna, instant noodles, canned ravioli, beans in tomato sauce or syrup, mixed vegetables, corn, chicken noodle soup, chunky stews, fruit cups, juice boxes, and chocolate and vanilla pudding.
3. "Monetary support will be used for food and supplies purchase for TAC. Please note "love fund (TAC)" on the offering if you are giving monetary donations.

NCAC RE-OPENED FOR IN-PERSON SERVICE

Ontario is currently in Stage 3 of reopening the economy due to 4th wave of pandemic. Measures under Stage 3 do not limit the number of people attending religious gatherings indoors, but require 2 meters (6 feet) of social distance, and participants must wear facial masks.

With social distancing, capacity for in-person worship, in addition to the serving teams on duty, will be 26 to 50 seats (single seating plus groups of the same family). Due to limited seating, advance online registration and online COVID self-screening are needed for those who would like to attend in-person Sunday worship. Those who register for in-person Sunday worship can also attend the in-person Sunday school on the same Sunday.

As children do not have vaccines available to them for protection, there is no children or nursery program offered at this time. Masks must be worn when inside the church building.

If you are unable to register, you can continue to participate in online worship and online Sunday school. Please continue to pray for protection for all of us and for the in-person Services.

1. Sirwan and his family: Thank God for His protection and faithfulness. They arrived in Toronto on November 17. Please pray that they will adapt well here in Toronto. Mariwan, Sirwan's brother, has prepared all the daily necessities for the family. All they need is two working mobile phones and laptops. 2. Abdullah and his family: The application process started on August 20. Thank God that the family received the application number on October 28 so that they can continue to stay in Turkey and don't have to be sent back to Iraq. He is amazing and He listens and answers our prayer.
