IN-PERSON SUNDAY SERVICE BEGINS!

After careful consideration, Elders Board decided to resume In-person Sunday Services and Sunday school from February 27, 2022. Those who register for in-person Sunday worship can also attend the In-person Sunday school on the same Sunday.
