#### IN-PERSON SUNDAY SERVICE BEGINS!

After careful consideration, Elders Board decided to resume In-person Sunday Services and Sunday school from February 27, 2022. With social distancing, the seating capacity in addition to the serving teams on duty will be 50 seats. Those who register for in-person Sunday worship can also attend the In-person Sunday school on the same Sunday.

In-Person Services for February and March: English – March 6, & 20 Cantonese – February 27, March 13 & 27.

Due to limited seating, online registration and online COVID self-screening are needed for those who like to attend in-person Sunday worship. Masks must be worn when inside the church building.

If you are unable to register, you can continue to participate in online worship and online Sunday school. Please continue to pray for protection for all of us and the In-person Services.

Our C&MA District urges local churches to trust God's timing in all of this and to honour our government and health officials for their hard work. All other ministries of NCAC will continue to be online till further notice.
