IN-PERSON SUNDAY SERVICE!

After careful consideration, Elders Board decided to resume In-person Sunday Services and Sunday school from February 27, 2022. With social distancing, the seating capacity in addition to the serving teams on duty will be 50 seats. Those who register for in-person Sunday worship can also attend the In-person Sunday school on the same Sunday.
