SUNDAY SERVICES TO RESUME IN MAY!

Church will resume weekly in-person Sunday worship services and Sunday school starting in May: while continuing with our online worship platform.

As Covid restriction on capacity limit is lifted by Ontario government, and almost all of our congregations have received full vaccination, restriction on worship services capacity and requirement of pre-registration will be lifted. Attendees can adjust their level of social distancing according to personal health needs.

Small groups, fellowships and committees can book church facilities for meetings by contacting Elders. Since the pandemic is not over, mask-wearing and no food guidelines remain in effect while inside the church facility.

Attendees are to do Covid symptoms self-screening check before coming to church. Children ministry will be consulting parents to determine when the in-person program for children will resume. Please pray for the gradual restoration of all of our in-person activities.
