SUNDAY SERVICES RESUMES!

We have resumed our weekly in-person Sunday worship services and Sunday school while continuing with our online worship platform.

As Covid restriction on capacity limit is lifted by Ontario government, and almost all of our congregations have received full vaccination, restriction on worship services capacity and requirement of pre-registration will be lifted.
