IN PERSON SUNDAY SERVICES

We have resumed our weekly in-person Sunday worship services and Sunday school while continuing with our online worship platform.

As Covid restriction on capacity limit is lifted by Ontario government, and almost all of our congregations have received full vaccination, restriction on worship services capacity and requirement of pre-registration is lifted. Attendees can adjust their level of social distancing according to personal health needs.
