Praise the Lord! As of last Sunday, we have raised \$102,558.00 in NCAC Mission Fund, reaching almost 76.7% of our annual target of \$133,700. Please continue to pray for needs of the C&MA Global Advance Fund, the Mission Field workers and their ministries. Pray for God's provision to cover the shortfalls of \$31,142.00 in the Mission Fund yearend target.

FINANCE UPDATE

We have received \$221,059 of General Fund by the end of October, compared to actual expenses (\$281,594), we have a deficit of \$60,535 (21.5%). We still have 4 Sundays before the year is up. Please pray for it. God is faithful, and He will come through.

IN PERSON SUNDAY SERVICES

As Covid restriction on capacity limit is lifted by Ontario government, and almost all of our congregations have received full vaccination, restrictions on worship services capacity and requirement of pre-registration is dropped. We have resumed our weekly in-person Sunday worship services and Sunday school while continuing with our online worship platform. All Worshipers can adjust their level of social distancing according to personal health needs when sitting in the sanctuary.

All Small groups, fellowships and committees leadership can book church facilities for meetings via the booking links. Meanwhile, the use of food in church facility is permitted following Ontario health protocol guidelines. Wearing of mask is required when preparing or distributing food, except when eating.
